To Parents of the Area:

Perhaps you have read reports that a group of parents near Victoria Park are anxious to organize a Tennis Club. No doubt, if you have thought about it, you will agree that there is a very pressing need for additional tennis facilities in the City and more particularly on the West Side where, at present, none exist for our many young people.

Recently, the Parks Board approved a site for the location of two courts in Victoria Park, in the low area, west of the Park Pavilion. Estimates are being requested for the installation of two full-sized asphalt courts with proper drainage and surrounded by an appropriately-high, chain-link fence. A preliminary figure of \$7,500 is being considered. A group of parents, who are interested in providing the courts for their children to take instruction and enjoy this delightful game, have met to discuss and work out the initial phase for such an undertaking.

Would you, as a parent, be interested in participating in this project? In order to learn if there are sufficient people willing to join and thereby assure the financing, would you take a "family" membership costing \$25.00 for the year 1962? Certain families, where there are a number of young children, might feel inclined to reserve such a membership for two or more years and this advice would be welcomed.

May we have a decision from you within the next ten days? A letter, addressed to me at 31 Forest Road, would assist the Committee in its future planning.
